Recent additions to California Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) expanded the list of chemicals that are believed to cause certain diseases or birth defects. As a result, several popular screen and pad printing ink brands, such as Poly-All ink for polypropylene, cannot be utilized anymore on products made in or shipped to California.

Sapphire line of screen/pad printing inks from Inkcups Now Corporation complies with Proposition 65 as well as European EN 71 Toy Safety standards. As a replacement for Poly-All, Inkcups offers Sapphire DP series. In addition to being legal in California, DP series eliminates the need to pre-treat surfaces as this ink has excellent adhesion to untreated polypropylene.

As for companies that require printing at even higher safety standards, Inkcups Now provides Class VI certified Sapphire MB and J3 series. These medical grade inks are formulated for printing on syringes, auto-suture, medical packaging and other products that contact with human body or drugs.

Sapphire series are available in 21 standard color shades. A twelve color mixing system and free formulation guide is available for the generation of Pantone colors. For printing onto dark and translucent substrates the series feature a High Density ink product line in a complete line of colors.
